Street naming & numbering – Land south of Arlesey Road, Stotfold – 161 new dwellings	
<p>Proposed street names for the above development are:</p> <p>Whitemore. Mill Machinery. In 1898 a cast-iron hursting frame was installed by <u>Whitmore</u> and Binyon of Wickham Market in Suffolk, the Rolls-Royce makers of Mill equipment.</p> <p>Dawson: Henry Dawson owned the Mill from 1757 -1767</p> <p>Eskil . Eskil (of Ware) Lords of Stotfold, referenced in the Domesday book.</p> <p>Radwell . The next mill down the river Ivel from Stotfold Mill is Radwell.</p> <p>Pestell .James Pestell was one of three millers who went bankrupt.</p> <p>Butterley – Is a brick made at the Arlesey Plant.</p> <p>Waldock – A family who owned the mill.</p> <p>Sander – James Sander used to own the mill.</p> <p>Mill – The famous mills</p> <p>Deadline for responses 26th April 2019</p>
