## 3. Good Neighbours

- 3.1 A successful officers' meeting had been held. The volunteer pack and confidentiality form are nearly complete and will be sent out to all.
- 3.2 The Town Clerk is applying to BRCC for a grant of £300 to provide insurance, a phone and initial running costs for that.
- 3.3 A bank account with 3 signatories has been set up.
- 3.4 A constitution is being customised.
- 3.5 At the next meeting on 16th September the volunteer pack, constitution will be finalised. All is in train to start at the end of October.
- 3.6 Articles about the scheme will be publicised in CBC Carers in Beds publication.
