CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL PROPOSES TO INTRODUCE WAITING RESTRICTIONS AT ANY TIME AT THE JUNCTION BETWEEN ASTWICK ROAD AND TAYLOR'S ROAD WITHIN STOTFOLD

<u>Reason for proposal:</u> The waiting restrictions are intended to address indiscriminate parking and to ensure that junctions are not obstructed by parked vehicles. Effect of the Order:

To introduce No Waiting at any time on the following lengths of roads in Stotfold:-

Double yellow lines running at the T Junction joining Astwick Road and Taylor's Road:

- Approximately 40m of double yellow lines extending from the driveway of No.1 Taylor's Road to a point 5m north of the radius kerb Astwick Road
- H-bar marking across vehicular crossover of No. 34 Astwick Road
- Approximately 20m of double yellow lines extending from the dropped kerb access of the driveway of No. 2b Taylor's Road to building line of No. 41 Astwick Road (extending across the existing vehicular crossover).
- Approximately 67m of double yellow lines extending from the dropped kerb vehicle crossover to No. 24 Astwick Road to No. 34 Astwick Road.
