CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL (DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT FOR CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE) (STOTFOLD: FOOTPATH NO. 32) MODIFICATION ORDER 2023

This Order is made by the Central Bedfordshire Council under Section 53(2)(b) of The Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement for Central Bedfordshire require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(i) of the Act, namely,

(c) the discovery by the surveying authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows:

(i) that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. Central Bedfordshire Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 14 March 2023
2. The Definitive Map and Statement for Central Bedfordshire as at 10 October 2014 shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as Central Bedfordshire Council (Definitive Map and Statement for Central Bedfordshire) (Stotfold: Footpath No. 32) Modification Order 2023

PART I

Modification of Definitive Map

Description of path or way to be added

Footpath No. 32, Stotfold

The length of Footpath No. 32, Stotfold to be added extends from its junction with Church Road at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 2185 3683 (Order map – point A) along a track in a generally north north-easterly direction for approximately 59 metres and past an electricity substation to the west to OS GR TL 2187 3688 (Order map – point B). It then continues in a generally north-easterly direction for approximately 36 metres to OS GR TL 2189 3692 (Order map – point C) and then extends in a north-westerly direction along a track for approximately 6 metres to terminate at its junction with the eastern end of Home Close at OS GR TL 2189 3692 (Order map – point D).

The Footpath has a width of 5.5 metres at OS GR TL 2185 3683 (Order map – point A) narrowing to a width of 4 metres at OS GR TL 2187 3688 (Order map – point B). It continues with a width of 4 metres from OS GR TL 2187 3688 (Order map – point B) to OS GR TL 2189 3692 (Order map – point C) and then continues with a width of 2 metres from OS GR TL 2189 3692 (Order map – point C) to OS GR TL 2189 3692 (Order map – point D).

Modification of Definitive Statement

Variation of particulars of path or way

Stotfold **FP 32**
FROM: **Church Road**
TO: **Home Close**

DESCRIPTION:

The path is a footpath.

It starts at a junction with Church Road, Stotfold at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OS GR) TL 2185 3683 and extends along a track in a generally north north easterly direction for approximately 59 metres and past an electricity substation to OS GR TL 2187 3688 and then extends in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 36 metres to OS GR TL 2189 3692 and then extends in a north westerly direction along a track for approximately 6 metres to terminate at the eastern end of Home Close at OS GR TL 2189 3692.

The Footpath has a width of 5.5 metres at OS GR TL 2185 3683 (Order map – point A) narrowing to a width of 4 metres at OS GR TL 2187 3688 (Order map – point B). It continues with a width of 4 metres from OS GR TL 2187 3688 (Order map – point B) to OS GR TL 2189 3692 (Order map – point C) and then continues with a width of 2 metres from OS GR TL 2189 3692 (Order map – point C) to OS GR TL 2189 3692 (Order map – point D).

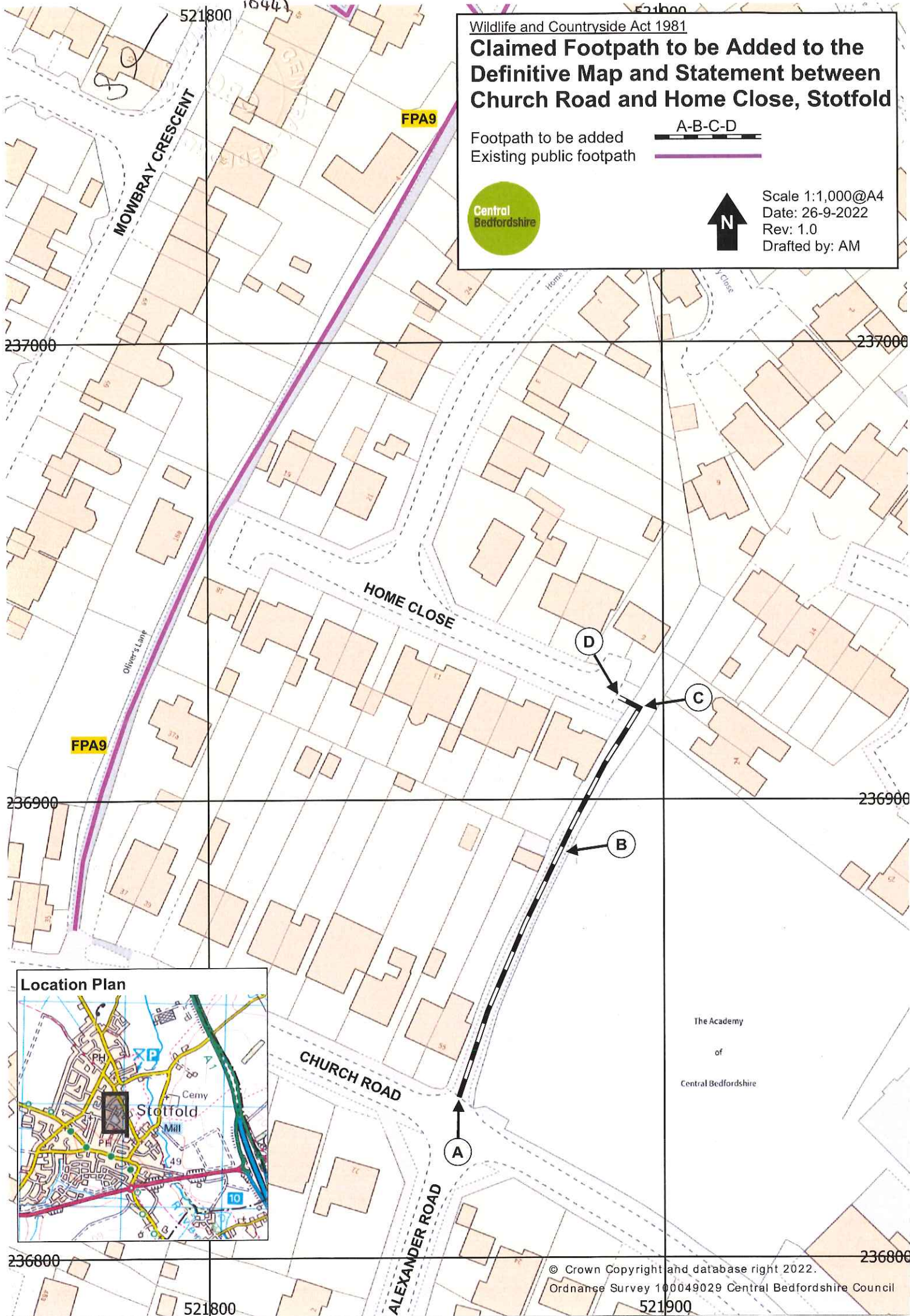
Claimed Footpath to be Added to the Definitive Map and Statement between Church Road and Home Close, Stotfold
