Councillors

After the Elections in May we were left with two vacancies. These were filled by co-option by Satinderjit Dhaliwal and Tim Naisbitt. During the year Cllr Mrs Turner resigned for personal reasons. This vacancy has yet to be filled.

News from Council and the Committees

All our Council and Committee meetings are open for people to attend. To speak on any item that is of interest to you, for

up to three minutes, see the Clerk before the meeting.

This is particularly important for the Planning Committee, your input is valuable either in writing or by coming and speaking.

During the year a request was made to Central Bedfordshire Council for a Governance Review for Fairfield Park. After two stages of public consultation the outcome has been determined. There will be a new parish council for Fairfield Park from April 1st 2013, with elections taking place in May 2013. From 1st April 2013 Stotfold Town Council will cease to be the third tier authority for that area.

The housing development between Grange Drive and the by-pass has increased in pace and the last housing areas of land are about to be built. The replacement for Roecroft School is now open.

The First Phase of the Community Leisure Centre Project has been planned to consist of Junior Football pitches, a toilet block and car parking. The work is to begin in the autumn of 2012. We are working to follow this with a phase 2, to include the re-location of the Senior Football Club.

This year there has been more crime, including metal thefts, than previously. It is understood to have been committed by a small number of adults. The police are working to stop this. In general the level of crime is down.

I would like to thank all those volunteers in the town who have continued in their efforts.

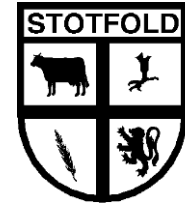
