News from Council and the Committees

This is particularly important for the Planning Committee, your input is valuable either in writing or by coming and speaking. The most recent application where public

input has been influential was an application in Brook Street.

We have had young children and youths come to talk to us about what they want in the town. The Recreation Grounds Committee ran a survey in our schools about the type of play equipment they would like in the town. As a result a zip wire is to be installed at the Riverside Playing Field. This is an illustration of the Town Plan in action. The Town Plan was published in 2009. All of Stotfold had the opportunity to input their ideas as to how they wanted to see Stotfold develop.

Last year I reported that work on Queen Street was imminent. Although some essential safety work has taken place at the Mill Lane junction, the real improvements have not yet been made.

There are about 100 houses occupied on the land south of Stotfold and the replacement for Roecroft School is well under-way.

The Community Leisure Centre Project is closer now than for some time. There is £500,000 in CBC Capital Budget to start during this calendar year with major sums being spent in the following financial years.

This year less damage has been caused to the town's property than previously, we hope the trend continues and is extended to less damage to residents' property. In general the level of crime is down.

With the new concept of the big society I would like to thank all those volunteers in the town who have continued in their efforts before they knew what it was called. This year we honoured four of them with our Citizens Award.
