CENTRAL BEDFORDSHIRE COUNCIL PROPOSES TO INTRODUCE WAITING RESTRICTIONS ON BUTTERCUP ROAD, STOTFOLD

Reason for proposal: Please note this is a retrospective consultation. The waiting restrictions are already in situ but the Legal Order required to enforce these is missing so we must re-consult in order to fulfil our statutory obligations.

Effect of the Order:

To introduce No Waiting at any time on the following length of road in Stotfold:-

1. Buttercup Road, (main length), east side, from a point approximately 3 metres north of the south flank wall of No.1 Buttercup Road, extending in a southerly direction to a point in line with the north flank wall of No.6 Buttercup Road.
2. Buttercup Road, (eastern spur), both sides, from the east kerb line of Buttercup Road (main length) extending in an easterly direction for approximately 10 metres.

To introduce No Waiting Monday to Friday from 8am to 9.30am and from 3pm to 4pm on the following length of road in Stotfold:-

1. Buttercup Road, (main length), north side, from a point approximately 4 metres north of the south flank wall of No.8 Buttercup Road, extending in a generally south-westerly direction to a point in line with the south flank wall of No.16 Buttercup Road.
2. Buttercup Road, (main length), south side, from a point approximately 6 metres south of the south flank wall of No.8 Buttercup Road, extending in a generally westerly direction to a point in line with the south flank wall of No.14 Buttercup Road.
