No access onto The Avenue? Plenty of room for off street parking in the area, 52 spaces in Co-op car park. Opticians over the road has less parking than the dentist. Re Bus stop outside dentist – only 3 buses per week stop there. The building extension is round to the side of The Avenue, as recommended. Doesn't interfere with Parking. No double yellow lines in the area.
