Members noted that there are more increasing occurrences of being unable to download plans currently up for consultation from the Central Beds Council planning webpages. The Clerk will write to the Planning Department expressing our concern that, although we receive hard copies of applications, not all residents are able to view them, and so look to download the information.

Residents and Council Members are finding that for some applications, they are unable to download the application information during the consultation period. This is not acceptable.

The Chairman advised that at a recent Town & Parish Council Conference, he spoke to some local Town and Parish Council Chairmen about mutual dissatisfaction of the planning process, particularly in Central Bedfordshire. The Chairman will be meeting with the Chairmen of Cliffton and Shefford Town Councils on an informal basis to gauge strength of feeling. He feels it is important that some joined up thinking takes place, and local Councils establish each other's views. The issues seem to stem from central Government and the National Planning Policy Framework, and therefore we also need to work with Central Beds Council who have to follow rules and guidelines set down for them. This will present a stronger argument to central Government. He will report back to this Committee, for further discussion.
